

TIP ACTIVITIES

- Tutor students
- Assist in open library
- Provide homebound instruction
- Help with conference, district, state, fairs, exhibitions, and/or competitions
- Summer educational programs with students, *pending administration approval*
- Develop and implement parent/child learning center night/ parent orientations
- Monitor Saturday detentions

** Beginning with the 2013-14 school year, each eligible teacher will be paid \$20/hour for hours contributed to the TIP Program, with \$1,200 being the maximum amount earned. TIP hours will have to be accumulated from the seven (7) approved activities listed above. Please note that to receive the \$1,200, the teacher will have to log sixty hours ($\$1200/\$20=60$ hours).

Each teacher involved with the TIP Program will be required to photocopy his/her monthly TIP forms and give a copy to the Superintendent by the last day of each month, except May (due on the last day of the school year). Payment for TIP will be made in June. Each eligible teacher will need to inform the Superintendent by April 1st if he/she plans to participate in the TIP Program for the next school year.

Please note that it is the responsibility of the teacher to turn in his/her forms to Mr. Bottoms for reimbursement.
